



Transfer Program Guide
Indian Hills Community College (IHCC) Associates of Arts (AA)
to
Bachelor of Science in Accounting (BS)

Completion of the AA degree at IHCC fulfills the Essential Skills, Modes of Inquiry, and Intercultural Perspective requirements in Truman State University's Liberal Studies Program (LSP). Students transferring with an AA are still required to complete a 3-credit JINS course, and to demonstrate elementary proficiency in one foreign language, in addition to the remaining major requirements, required support, and the Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science requirement, and the Missouri Statute requirements. In addition to completing the required courses for the AA degree at IHCC, students intending to transfer to Truman State University are advised to take the courses below as part of their degree program at IHCC. Completion of the courses below prior to transferring to Truman will enable incoming Associate of Arts transfer students to enroll in upper-division courses (300+) in the School of Business in a timely manner. Students transferring without the courses below, or without completing an AA degree may require additional terms to meet all pre-requisites for upper-division coursework in the School of Business.

Note on Foreign Language:

All students at Truman State University are required to demonstrate elementary proficiency in one foreign language, which requires up to two semesters to complete. Students pursuing a BA degree are required to demonstrate intermediate proficiency in one foreign language, which requires up to four semesters to complete. All transfer students are recommended to begin their language study as early as possible, to ensure a smooth path to graduation.

Other Program Requirements:

Admission to the Upper-Division of the School of Business is required prior to enrollment in most 300-level BSAD and ACCT courses. Students may apply to the Upper-Division upon meeting the following requirements:

1. Completion of 40 credits, including the following courses with a grade of C or better:

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ENG 190 Writing as Critical Thinking (IHCC ENG 105)

COMM 170 Public Speaking (IHCC SPC 112 or SPC 101)

STAT 190 Basic Statistics (IHCC MAT 156)

MATH 192 Essentials of Calculus (IHCC MAT 210)

BSAD 153 Introduction to Business Data Analytics

ACCT 220 Intro to Financial Accounting (IHCC ACC 121)

2. An overall cumulative GPA of 2.75

3. Submission of a semester-by-semester plan to fulfill graduation requirements

4. Students should be enrolled in or have completed the following courses with a grade of C or better:

BSAD 234 Legal Environment of Business (IHCC BUS 188)

ECON 200 Principles of Macroeconomics (IHCC ENC 120) AND ECON 201 Principles of Microeconomics (IHCC ECN 121)

OR ECON 205 Principles of Economics

ACCT 221 Introduction to Management Accounting (IHCC ACC 122)

5. Pass Excel Competency Test

6. Submission of a current resume

In order to graduate with a Bachelor's degree, all students at Truman State University are required to satisfy the following:

- A 2.0 minimum cumulative GPA (unless a higher requirement is specified), a 2.0 minimum GPA in all coursework completed at Truman, and a 2.0 major GPA
- 120 total credits
- 40 credits of upper-level courses (courses numbered 300+)
- 45 credits must be completed in residence, 28 of which must immediately precede completion of requirements for the degree, 15 of which must be major requirements
- The Truman Week requirement is waived for all transfer students.
- Completion of the Liberal Studies Program (LSP). LSP requirements can be found in the Truman State University catalog.
- 63 credits of courses with the Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS) designation. A list of LAS-designated courses can be found in the Truman State University Catalog.
