Biochemistry is Being Required at More Med Schools

One semester of Biochemistry (at Truman, this is usually CHEM 335) is being required at more medical schools than in the past — and this trend will probably continue until it's required universally. Right now, approximately 50% of med schools require it while the other 50% recommend it.

Truman strongly recommends taking it before you take the MCAT. You should also look at the specific schools you are interested in to see if they require or recommend it.
